- Program Name:** Master Gunsmithing
- Program Length:** This program is designed to be completed in 16 months (2496 total clock hours; predominately hands-on training).
- Program Cost:** This program will cost \$35,474 if completed within normal time. There may be additional costs for living expenses. These costs were accurate at the time of posting, but may have changed.
